As some of you may remember, Armando is originally a baker by trade. When I (Megan) met him, he was making donuts in his home and selling them on the street. Well, I'm pleased to announce that the donuts are back! Yesterday, Armando, along with a few of the older boys from *Panes y Pececillos*, made their inaugural batch of donuts... 260 of them to be exact! Thanks to generous donations from some of you, we will also be purchasing a commercial oven, so that they can start baking traditional Mexican sweet bread as well. Armando will be teaching the kids a trade as they help him make donuts and bake bread. We also have a friend here in Tijuana who is a cake decorator; she will be giving classes to the interested moms and kids once a week. And finally, the kids and parents from *Panes y Pececillos* will have the opportunity to sell the donuts and sweet bread, allowing them to bring in income for their families. Our hope for the *Panes y Pececillos* bakery is that instead of just "giving a fish" through breakfast club, we can also be "teaching HOW to fish" by teaching a trade.
